First of all, let us introduce ourselves...



So, what have we been up to this past school year? Here is a summary of the main events we have throughout the year and some of the things we have been able to pay for both before and since the pandemic.

Christmas Fair



This is one of our biggest fundraisers of the year and a wonderfully festive start to the Advent season. We have Santa, fun stalls, food and drink and prizes to be won! In 2023 this event made over £500 for our children!! We held the fair on a Friday evening, straight from school last year and this was very successful - we will soon be setting the date for this year's Christmas Fair so watch this space!

During the year we hold a number of 'Movie Nights' which have been very popular across the whole school! We provide a drink and snack for each child and ensure the film is rated 'U' so appropriate even for our youngest children. Each of these can raise over £100 in funds 😊

It's mainly a social event for the children and any money we make is a lovely bonus.
